NURSERY NEWS



Our week started with a PE session on the field, with Kelley. The children were making their way around a course, where they had to crawl, balance, jump and throw beanbags into a bucket. We also enjoyed a few games of 'What's the time Mr Wolf', making the most of the big space to run in!!

Katrina was looking at rhyming words on Tuesday and the children got to play a game where they had to match together the words that sounded the same. They were also using their fine motor skills to colour and cut out extra playing pieces, to add to the game. Then in the afternoon, the pre-school children went for another 'play and explore' session with Miss Grizzell, in Class One, whilst some of the Class One children came into nursery to play with our younger children.

Wednesday, the children were talking about how important it is not to drop litter and to keep our 'world' clean. They formed small 'tidy up teams' and helped clean up nursery and the surrounding area. Outside, they were busy working out ways of getting the balls down the plastic pipes and into the pool of water at the end. It was great to see them having a go and trying out new ideas for themselves.

On Thursday, the children were creating their own islands with Kelley. They were choosing what landscapes they thought they should have and were talking about where each area should go, using their positional language. Our Thursday 'fun snack' was slices of pizza, that Donna shared with the group - these were a huge success, with clean plates all around!! In the afternoon, everyone took part in some formula one style racing around the playground, using the ride on toys.

We have finished our week off with a trip down to forest school with Lauren. Using magnifying glasses the children have been hunting for bugs and looking at them closely, before releasing them safely back into the forest area. They have also been playing their favourite - Hide and Seek and playing in the mud kitchen.

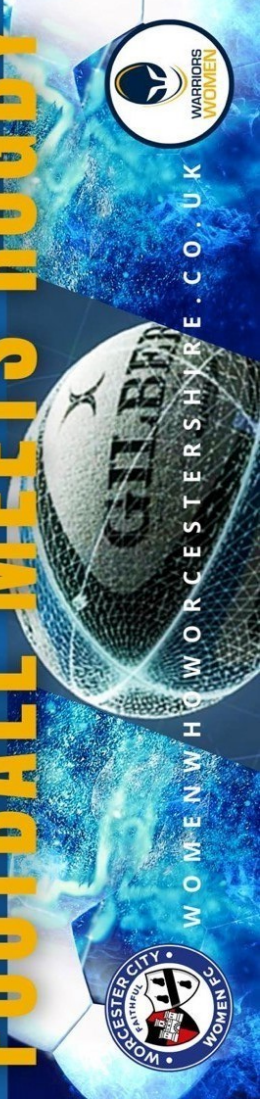
