We had a quieter start to this week, on Monday, with only the younger children in nursery. We spent the day playing games together and tidying up the nursery garden. They all had a great time and were very excited to tell us all about it upon their return to nursery.

Tuesday was another different kind of day, this time we joined the older school children, mixing with siblings and friends to take part in a multi skills morning. The children got to practise a variety of sports skills as well as learning a few new ones through a range of different activities that had been set up in and around the school. In the afternoon, we were entertained by some of the school's talented children in their version of 'Cradley's got Talent.' The children watched in delight as they witnessed singers, dancers, acrobats, musicians and comedians. You could tell how impressed they were by the whoops, cheers and claps they gave to each of the performers!!

On Wednesday, the children spent a lot of their time playing outside together, sharing the wheeled toys and taking it in turns to play the giant connect four game. We also had great fun creating a den using some blankets. The children really enjoyed their little den area and made it even cosier by adding cushions, a table and chairs. It was a perfect spot for everyone to sit and enjoy a chocolate biscuit at the end of the day.
