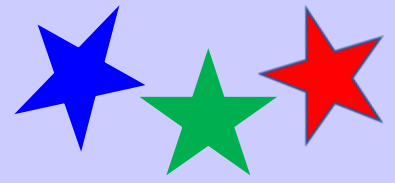

# NURSERY NEWS



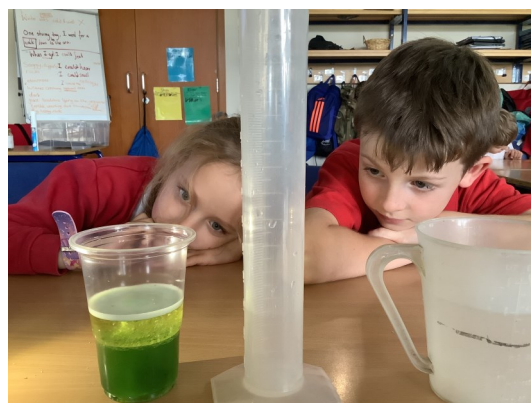
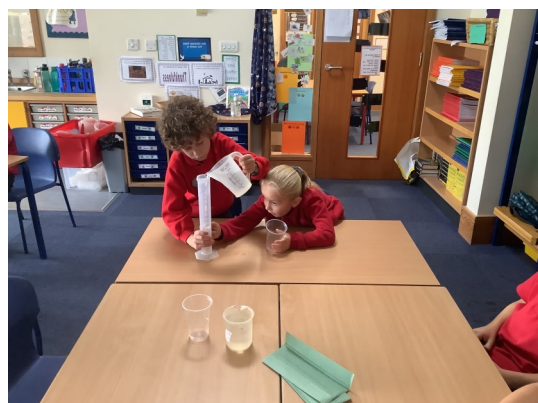
The nursery children started their week off in a very active way. They had a PE session with Katrina that had them dancing around and warming up their bodies ready for some exercise. They then went in to play a game that involved collecting up coloured bean bags and placing them in the matching coloured hoops. Not only did this work on their colour recognition, but it also had them moving their bodies in different ways as they crouched and stretched to reach the bean bags that they needed. On Tuesday, Kelley had turned a tuff tray into 'Cradley Village' and the children were using wooden blocks to build familiar landmarks that they remembered visiting or seeing. They introduced small world people and cars into the village too, so that they could play imaginatively and create their own scenarios.

Wednesday was a day about books, Katrina set out a wide variety of books for the children to look at, whether this was in a small group or independently. She reminded the children of how they should look after books and take care when turning the pages. Katrina went on to share one of her favourite stories with the children and each of the children got to say what they liked or didn't like about it themselves. On Thursday, Lauren spent time with the children talking about places they have visited around the world. Together they looked at photographs from some very special places that the children have visited and chatted about where it was, what the weather was like and what they did when they were there. Lauren used maps and globes, to point out to the children where their special place was and how far away it was from 'home.'

To finish the week, the children have headed out on their weekly welly walk, through the forest school area. They have been using the same physical skills as Monday, crouching, and stretching, reaching for numbers that have been hidden high and low. The children have also thought about where else they might see numbers when out in a walk with their families.

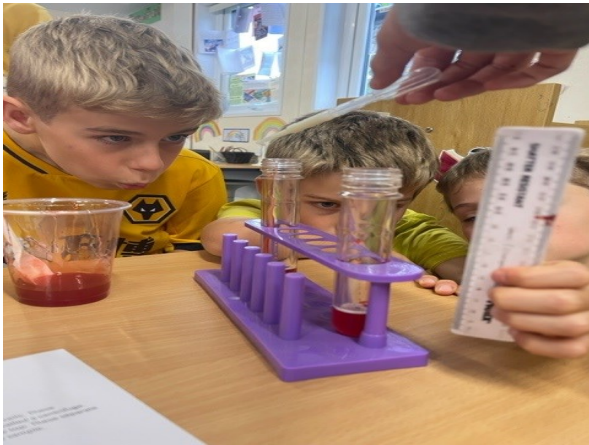
Class 3 did a science experiment, their aim was to see what happened to the oil and water when they put an effervescent tablet in the solution, they were all amazed with the results.
