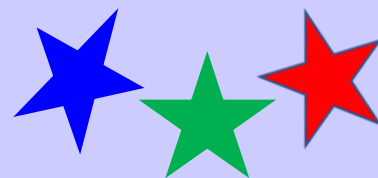

NURSERY NEWS



We started our nursery week off with a PE session in the hall. Lauren went through some of the children's favourite warm up songs that get them moving in different ways, using various muscles in the body. The 'Stand Up, Sit Down' song is proving to be as popular as ever with the children trying to be the first person to stand up or sit down!! In the afternoon, the children enjoyed some nursery rhymes and parachute games in the sun, with Kelley and Sandra.

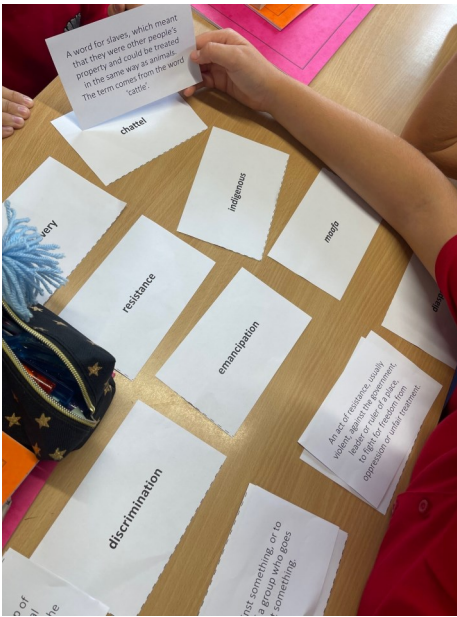
As part of our 'Let's Explore' topic, the children have been getting to know their nursery surroundings and on Tuesday, Lauren put them to the test. In small groups, the children were given a set of clues that they had to solve to get to a certain area of nursery, in order to find some 'treasure.' The children all worked well together in their groups at solving the clues and finding the correct area.

On Wednesday, Katrina shared the story 'My Cat Likes to Hide in Boxes' with the children. This story has some great rhyming words throughout and the children have been encouraged to start thinking about words that rhyme. They have also been practising their pouring and filling skills, using funnels and scoops in the yellow sand.

The children were exploring a variety of different textured materials on Thursday, with Kelley. They were using their own words to describe and talk about each of the objects in front of them. The seashells were very popular and a lot of the children were very keen to share stories about trips to the beach and the seaside. Some of the children have also had chance to create rainbow coloured tracks on a piece of paper, as they pushed their cars through the coloured blobs of paint.

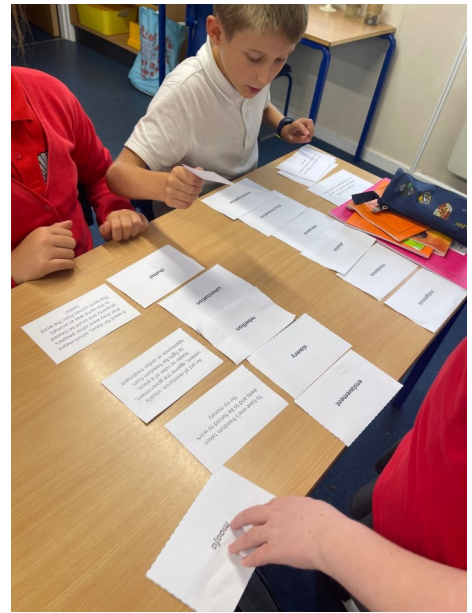

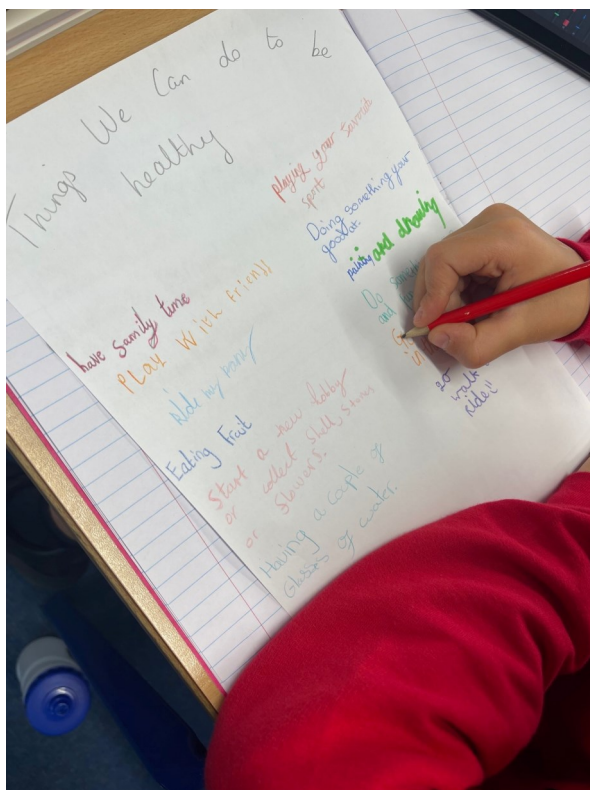
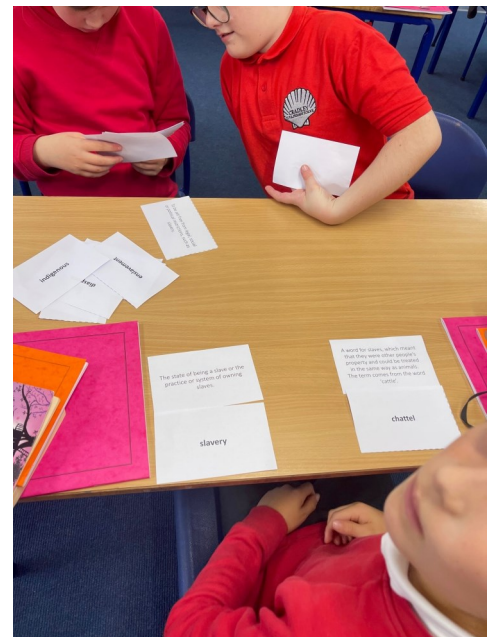


Class 5 have had a great first full week back at school!

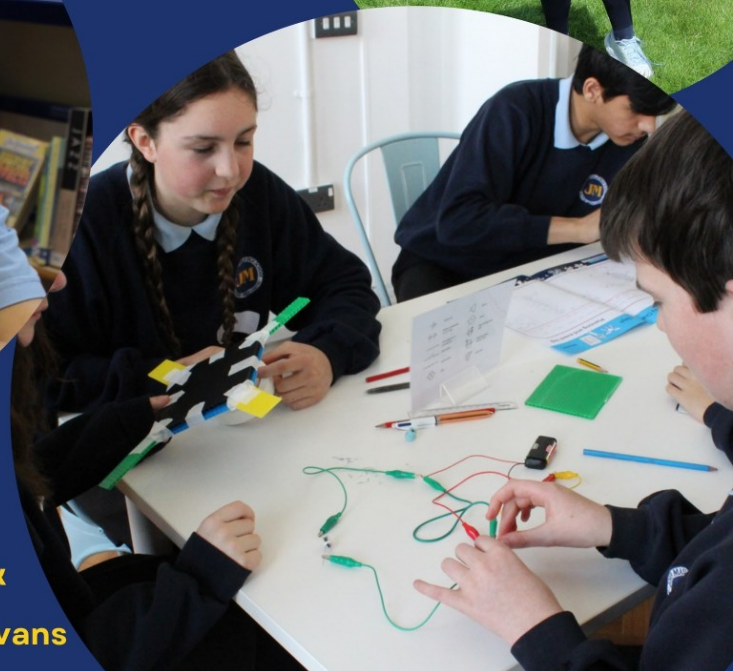

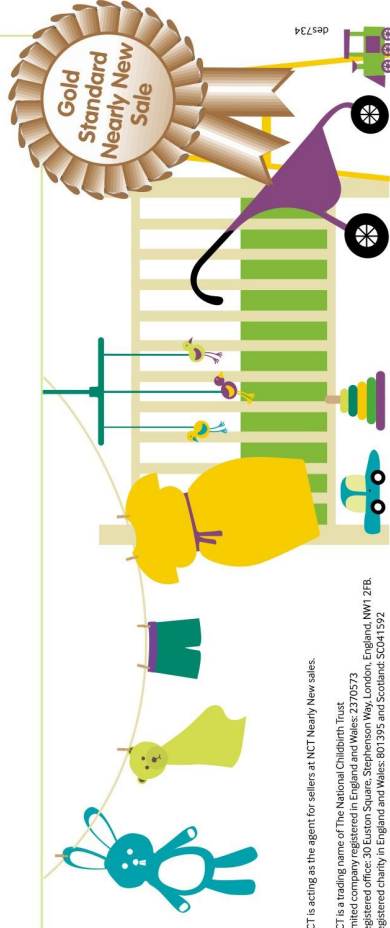
