Continuing with our theme of wild animals, our story of the week has been 'Elmer' - where the children have been joining in with lots of colourful activities and experiences. Looking at colours has helped us to use and develop mathematical skills, such as sorting, grouping and recognising patterns. The children have used sponge paints to help them copy repeating patterns onto a snake and have been using the tweezers to sort a tray full of objects by colour and type. We have been colour matching pom poms with the colours on Elmer's patchwork body and have been using pens and pencils to complete colour by numbers pictures.

Today, we have received a special visit from some 7 day old baby chicks. The children were so excited to see the cute fluffy little chicks and were very gentle as they stroked and petted them.

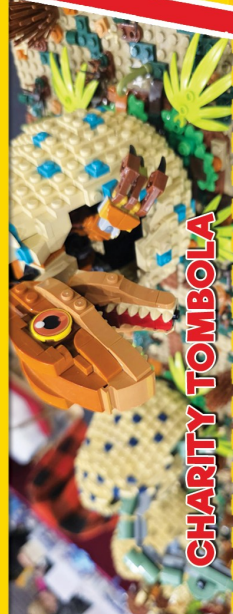
