Thrive

Having seen what an impact Thrive has been having for children who have 1:1 or group sessions, we wanted to make sure all children were able to access Thrive sessions.



We are now having fortnightly Thrive sessions in every class. During the half day on 8th October, all staff attended an afternoon of Thrive training where we learned about how to support children who were showing distressed or dysregulated behaviours. We also learned about how to support children to aid them not getting to that point.
