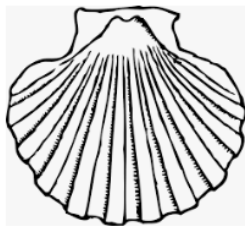
- Know that a faith community is when people gather because of their beliefs

Key Vocabulary

Faith	Strong religious belief
Community	A group of people living in the same place and having things in common
Ceremony	A formal occasion celebrating an event, achievement or anniversary
Baptism	Welcoming someone into the Christian faith with holy water
Eucharist Communion Lord's Supper	Ceremony remembering the Last Supper and the sacrifice Christians believe Jesus made
Bat/Bar Mitzvah	Jewish coming of age ceremony
Parable	A story told by Jesus with a meaning.

Interesting fact

The shell of St James is the symbol of Cradley School and of Cradley Church, which is called St James the Great.
