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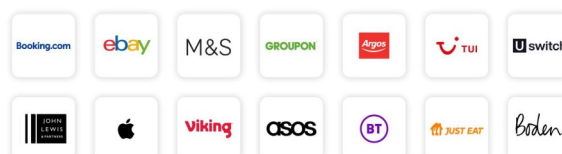

This week in Forest School, Class 2 had fun sawing wood ready to make necklaces in their next session.



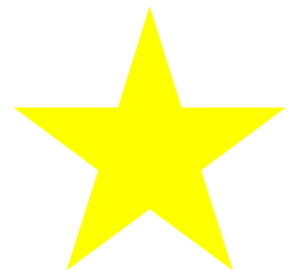
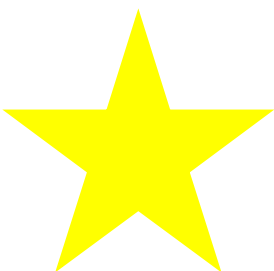
Christian Drama Club

A big well done to Skyla who was Star of the Week in her Karate lessons last week!

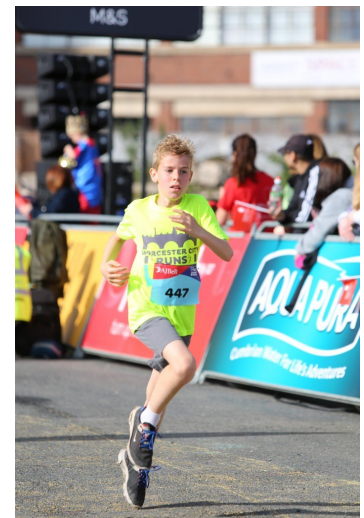
