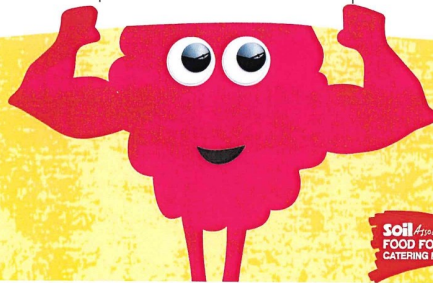

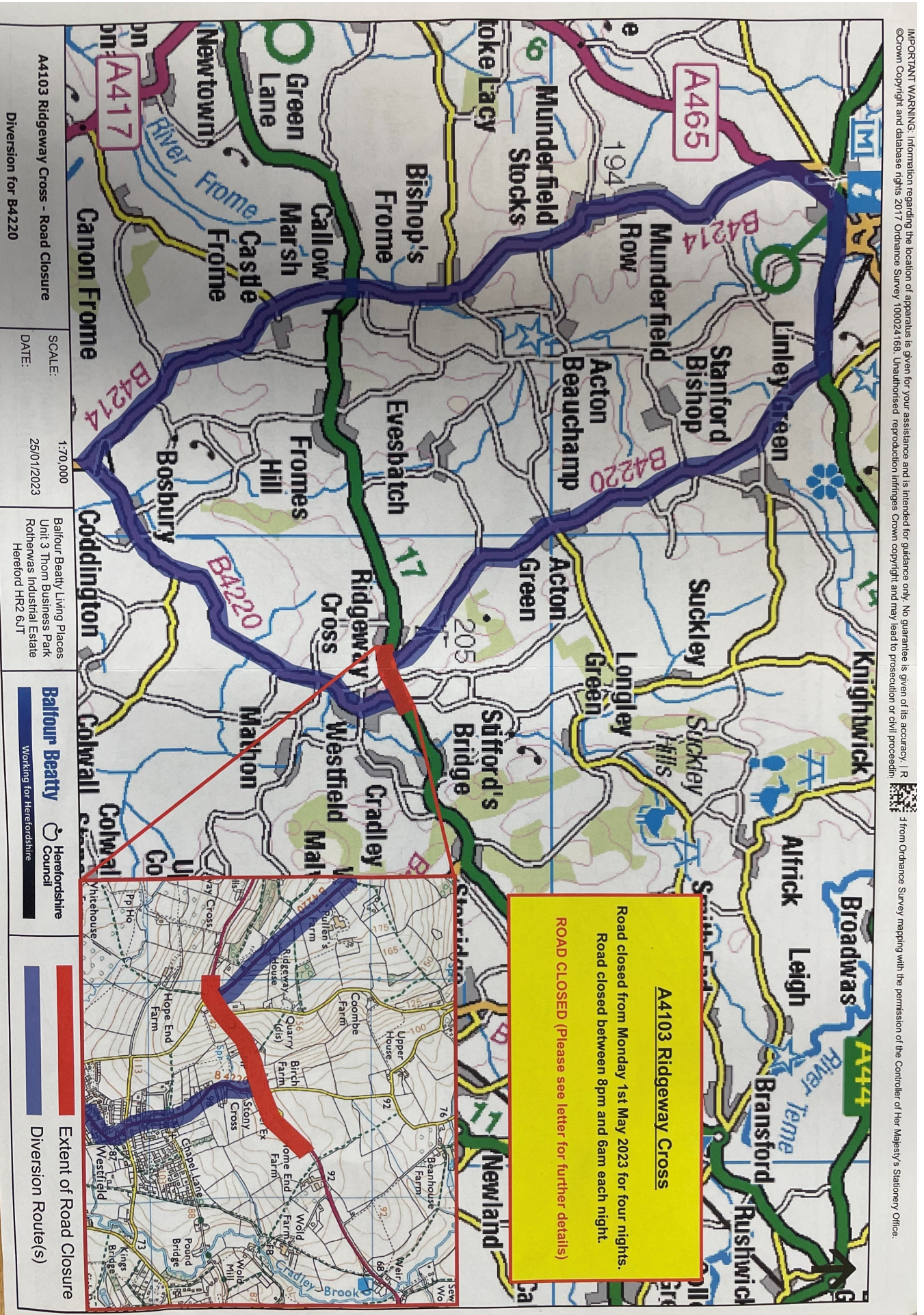
## Superstar Footballers

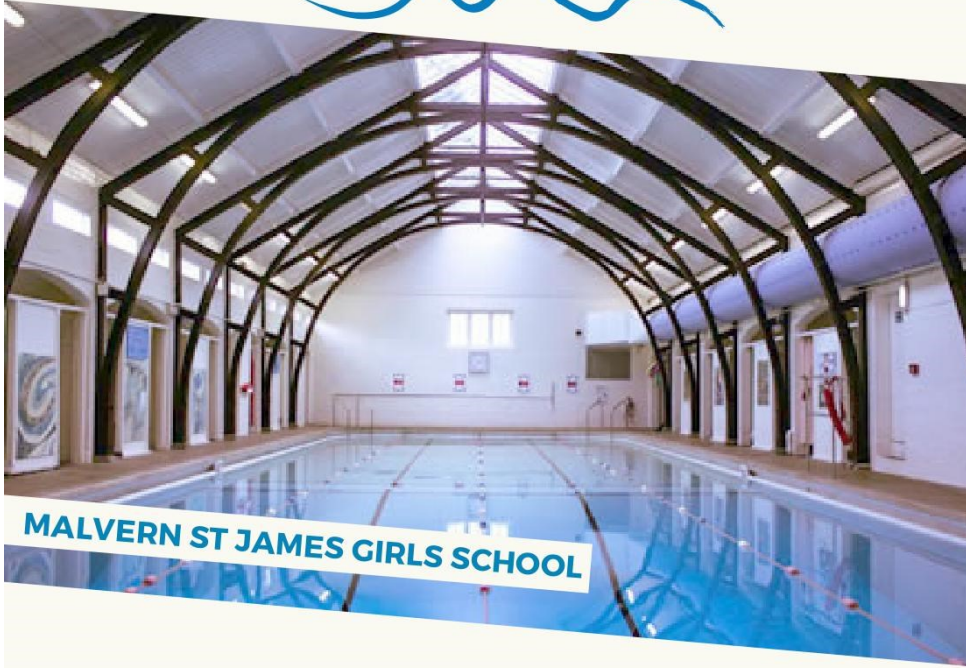
