Message from Mrs Jones

Dear Parents,

I am extremely proud of everyone in our school community for their hard work and commitment to home learning and working in school in such difficult circumstances. Our learning platform Seesaw is now working well for most people, after some initial glitches. It's lovely to see children each day through Zoom, either in collective worship, class teaching time or social time for Key Stage two. This really helps to keep in contact with our friends and colleagues. Everyone is doing an amazing job and although at times it may feel stressful and exhausting, remember you are doing better than you think.

You may have heard that Covid testing will begin in primary schools and nurseries very soon. This is very welcome as it will help to give those staff working in school the reassurance that those around them are Covid free. We have received supplies of the 30 minute lateral flow tests being used in secondary schools. The testing will begin with staff and they will administer them at home and report results to track and trace. We do believe that this may be rolled out for all children attending school and again these will be carried out by parents at home. These tests are currently optional but we advise everyone to get involved to help to stop the transmission of this virus within our community.
