We have continued our theme of Knights, Castles and Dragons this week in nursery. We started the week off with a PE session with Lauren, that involved the children searching for some hidden dragons eggs. Once they had found them they had to try and match the picture to its initial sound. They all did a great job at finding the eggs, so were rewarded with some tasty hot buttered toast!! Heavy rain stopped us from playing outside in the afternoon, so instead we took a virtual visit to a theme park and tried out lots of really big rollercoasters!!

On Tuesday, Katrina helped the children make their very own royal crowns. They got to choose their own coloured 'jewels', sequins and glitter to decorate their headpiece, before being crowned King or Queen. Some were very proud of their crowns and wanted to wear them for the rest of the day. In the afternoon, we spent some time on the field, enjoying a run around as well as playing with the bats, balls, scoops and frisbees.

Wednesday, the children all enjoyed a game of 'Bingo' with Kelley. They were very good at matching the pictures to their game cards. Using their special pens they crossed each picture off, to try and be the first to get a full house. Whilst outside, the children were having great fun in the mud kitchen, making a range of different recipes.

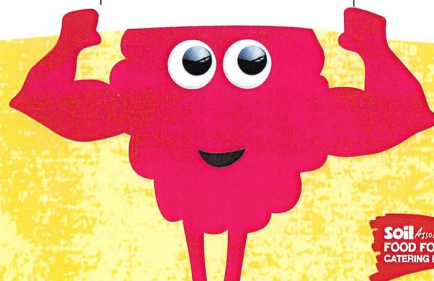

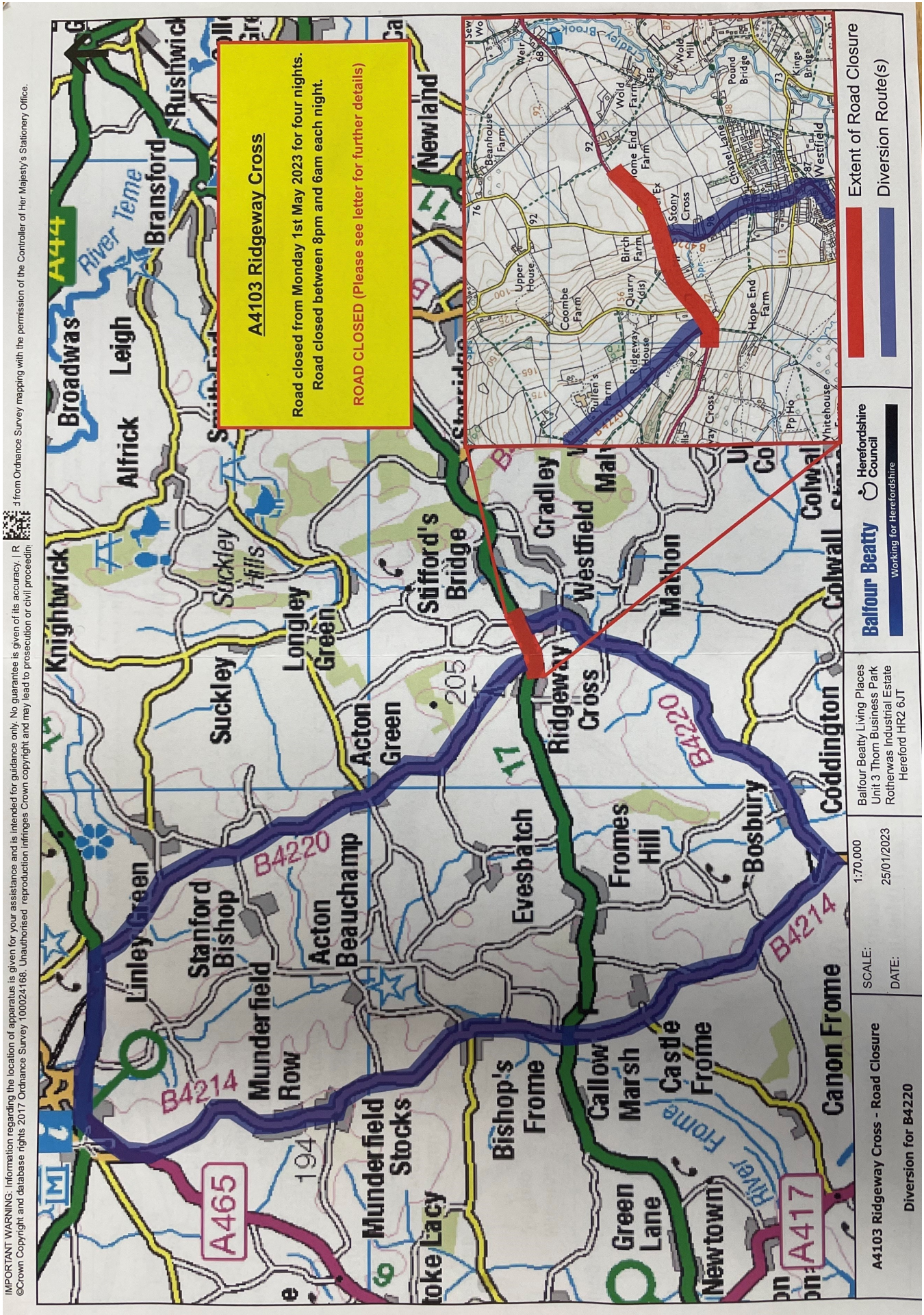
