History: In history, we will research the development of power over time, investigate what materials were used before plastic, carry out a waste survey, comparing modern materials with old and researching Thomas
Midgeley and Greta Thunberg.

Maths: We are starting the term with a big chunk of fractions and decimals. We need to learn equivalent fractions, find fractions of amounts and know how to add and subtract fractions. We will continue to practice the 4 operations; addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. We will also be looking at shape learning the names and properties of 2D and 3D shapes, looking at symmetry and angles. In June, the children will sit an online Multiplication Check so times tables will be a constant focus throughout the year.

PSHE: We will discuss the varying emotions and how to manage them, followed by how we can help in an accident or emergency.

Computing: We will be exploring programming and algorithms using Scratch, by creating characters, backdrops, effects and sprites.



Art: With a main focus on landscapes, we will study, compare and contrast various artists' landscape and cityscape work, before creating our own.



Geography: In line with our new topic, we will research sources of power, renewable electricity, investigate our own school's energy usage, and plan what we can do to help the fight against Global Warming!

English: We are beginning the term with a non-chronological report about Dragons. We will then write our own fantasy narrative based on The Selfish Giant. We will end the term with the book 'Bill's New Frock' by Anne Fine.


Spanish: We will be looking at exploring our environment, such as our house, rooms, furniture and prepositions, seasons, weather and clothes. Followed by animals and pets.
