Dear Parent/Guardian,

On Monday 22nd May, Class 5 will be visiting London to explore British cultures and experience our capital city. As you will know, it is a long drive and in order to achieve our fun-packed schedule, we need to leave earlier than usual. Therefore, we ask that children arrive at school for 6:15am and the coach **will** leave at 6:30am. We will then return to school for 9:15pm and therefore ask that children be picked up at this later time, please. Children can then come in at 10:30am the following day. If they cannot come in at that later time, then they must come in at 8:45am as normal.

The day includes a tour and workshop at the Houses of Parliament (https://learning.parliament.uk/en/visit-us/) and a visit and exhibition at the Natural History Museum (https://www.nhm.ac.uk/). In between, the children will relish life as a super tourist as they hop on the Thames Clipper, experience a tube ride and wave at iconic sights such as the London Eye, Downing Street and Buckingham Palace. Yes, we will snap lots of photos!

Children will need to wear smart school uniform including their red jumper (not black leavers hoodie) and preferably, a light waterproof jacket that would fit in their bag. However, they are allowed to wear trainers on this occasion as we will be walking at points. They will need to bring a small backpack containing a packed lunch, a water bottle and several healthy snacks.

The charge for this trip will be £25, in order to cover the cost of the coach, visits, boat and tube. We will need to cover these costs in order for the trip to run. If the cost of the trip is prohibitive, then please contact me at school to discuss alternative funding.
