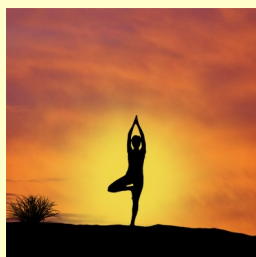

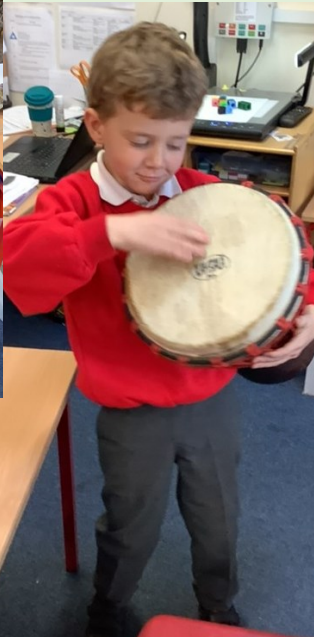




Class 2

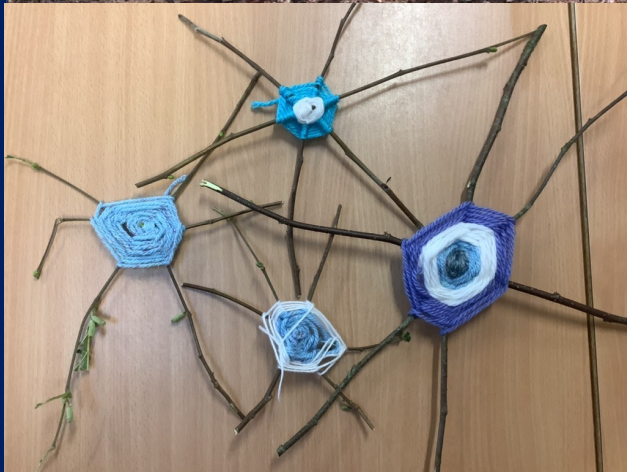
Class 2 had a fantastic time making music this week.
