Key Vocabulary

Pentecost	the Christian festival celebrating the coming of the Holy Spirit on the disciples of Jesus after his Ascension, held on the seventh Sunday after Easter.
Impact	a marked effect or influence.
Kingdom	a country, state, or territory ruled by a king or queen. A land that is under the control of a particular person or thing.
Holy Spirit	(in Christianity) the third person of the Trinity; God's spirit active in the world.
Disciples	a personal follower of Christ during his life, especially one of the twelve Apostles. (believers, 'champions' or advocates)
Symbols	a thing that represents or stands for something else, especially a material object representing something abstract, that you can't see/touch.
Crucifixion	. an ancient form of execution in which a person was nailed or bound to a cross. The killing of Jesus Christ
Resurrection	: (in Christian belief) the rising of Christ from the dead
Ascension	the action of rising to an important position or a higher level. Christ went up to heaven on the fortieth day after the Resurrection.
