Firstly, they drew a picture of a knight, then the preschool children had a go at some independent writing to describe their picture. Whilst outside, they practised balancing along beams, stepping across 'stones' and jumping into hoops.

The children all had a go at making a junk model dragon with Lauren on Wednesday. This was very popular with most of the children and they all worked hard on their creations. Those that weren't creating dragons decided that they were going to try and squirt everyone with water, using the pipettes and squirters. This was great for strengthening the muscles in their hands - getting them ready for writing!!

On Thursday, Brooke prepared the children a Union Jack platter, with strawberries, blueberries, marshmallows and white chocolate buttons for their snack - which they all were keen to try. They continued their countdown to the coronation during the morning with Kelley, looking at pictures of King Charles and beautiful crowns and then got to create their own royal crown to wear, complete with sequins, sparkles and glitter. 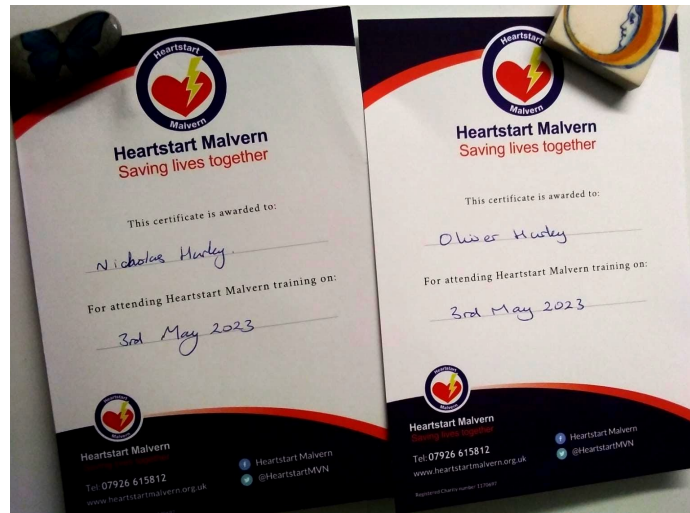
Coronation Garden

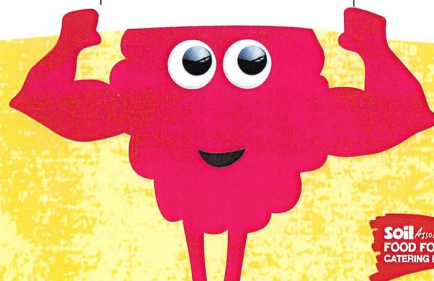

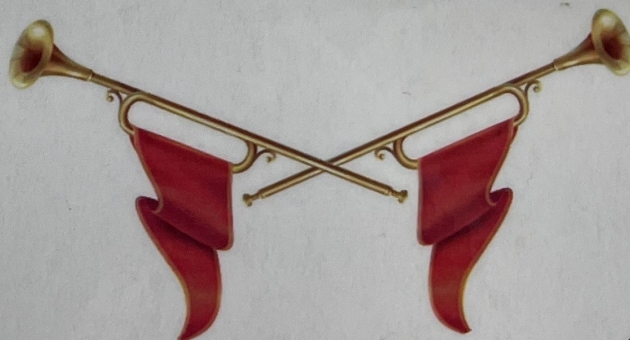

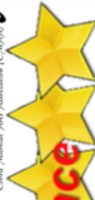
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
